

Student Parking

Parking Privileges at Pickens High

Student parking is a privilege open to eligible students who are both licensed and responsible drivers. Students applying for a permit must present a valid driver's license and verification of insurance. Seniors receive first priority. Parking permits cost \$20.00 and are for assigned parking spaces. Vehicles parked in unassigned locations are subject to being towed at the owner's expense. The following guidelines must be followed:

There are designated areas for SENIORS, JUNIORS, and SOPHOMORES to park. All parking in these areas is on first come first serve basis. THERE ARE NO RESERVED SPOTS. There is only one parking lot and it will be divided by signs that will indicate the areas by grade. No student may park in any parking area except for their grade area at any time.

1. All faculty and staff parking will be in a different lot in front of the school. Parking rules are in effect from 7:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. every day that school is in session. Any student parking in a faculty lot before 4PM will lose parking privileges for 20 school days.
2. Any student vehicle parked on campus must have a valid Pickens High School parking tag displayed where the number can be read at all times. B.J. Skelton parking stickers are not valid on the Pickens High School campus.
3. Parking tags will cost \$20.00. Replacement parking tags (for lost parking tags) will be \$10.00. No transfer or switching of tags will be allowed. A student may not buy a tag and then allow another to use his/her tag unless the student purchasing the tag is riding with the other student all the time.
4. Students must be parked in a proper parking space (proper space being a space drawn off with paint by the school) and in the area designated by their parking tag.
5. Any student buying a parking sticker must have a valid South Carolina driver's license (not a permit). Parking stickers must be displayed at all times in the front windshield so that the SCHOOL ASSIGNED HANG TAG NUMBER can be read by school officials.
6. The school administration reserves the right to remove any student parking privilege for excessive absences or tardies. (Excessive would be more than 10 absences in a year or 5 tardies in a nine week period.)
7. Dangerous or destructive driving may result in permanent loss of parking privileges. PHS is a closed campus.
8. YOU CAN NOT LEAVE CAMPUS DURING LUNCH OR ANY TIME WITHOUT EARLY DISMISSAL OR PROPERLY SIGNING OUT. If you leave campus without properly signing out you will lose parking privileges for 20 school days, if you are carrying another student you will lose parking privileges for 45 school days.

Consequences for Illegal Parking

1. Each student will receive one warning.
2. Second and Third violations will result in a fine of \$10 each.
3. Any violation after the third will result in loss of parking privileges for the remainder of the semester.
4. Students who have lost privileges and are parked on campus should expect their car to be towed.
