Graduation Supplies:

Please remember that prices do increase the longer you wait to place your order. All orders placed online will be mailed directly to your home.

Need Virtual SC Courses?

If you are interested in taking any initial credit courses or credit recovery courses, through Virtual SC, registration for the next term begins **January 3 – January 17**. Classes will begin January 24 and end with final exams on May 3, 2018. Registration also begins for **CR classes on Jan. 3 with classes ending on May 6.**

Attention College Athletes:

If you have taken ANY initial credit class through Virtual SC and you plan to play an NCAA sport in college, you MUST contact Virtual SC at the end of this school year and have them send an official transcript to the NCAA Eligibility Center. You will need to contact Katina Montgomery with Virtual SC at (803)734-8039. Do not put your eligibility in jeopardy; take care of this as soon as possible.

NCAA Clearinghouse: Potential College Athletes

Seniors who are prospective college athletes who have not already registered with the NCAA Clearinghouse, please do so immediately. You may register with the Clearinghouse at: www.eligibilitycenter.org and there is a \$80 fee. Please see Mrs. Cudd if you believe you qualify for a fee waiver. Please do not wait until the last minute to take care of this. Your eligibility could be jeopardized.
